**Liturgical Tidbits:** *Applause* by Paul Turner

 (cont.) Gradually, applause has found a fitting place within our worship. In fact, the rite for the ordination of a priest invites the people to give their assent to the choice of these candidates for service "according to local custom." Well, everybody applauds. The action celebrates God's choice, the church's unity, and the candidate's spiritual discernment.

Other occasions merit the same response. Applause can often be heard in support of a newly married couple. It congratulates a couple on their anniversary for the witness they give the community. It affirms a homily. It rejoices

with children on their first communion day. It thanks a choir for uplifting our hearts in prayer.

Applause serves best when it expresses our unity in faith. It ultimately is directed toward God, the creator of all, the one responsible for all human accomplishment. It does with our hands what we do with our voices whenever we shout praise.

"Clap your hands, all you peoples," acclaims Psalm 47.

"Shout to God with loud songs of joy."
