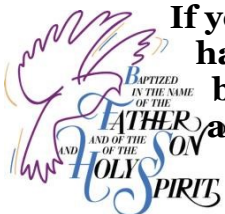
Baptism Prep Sessions

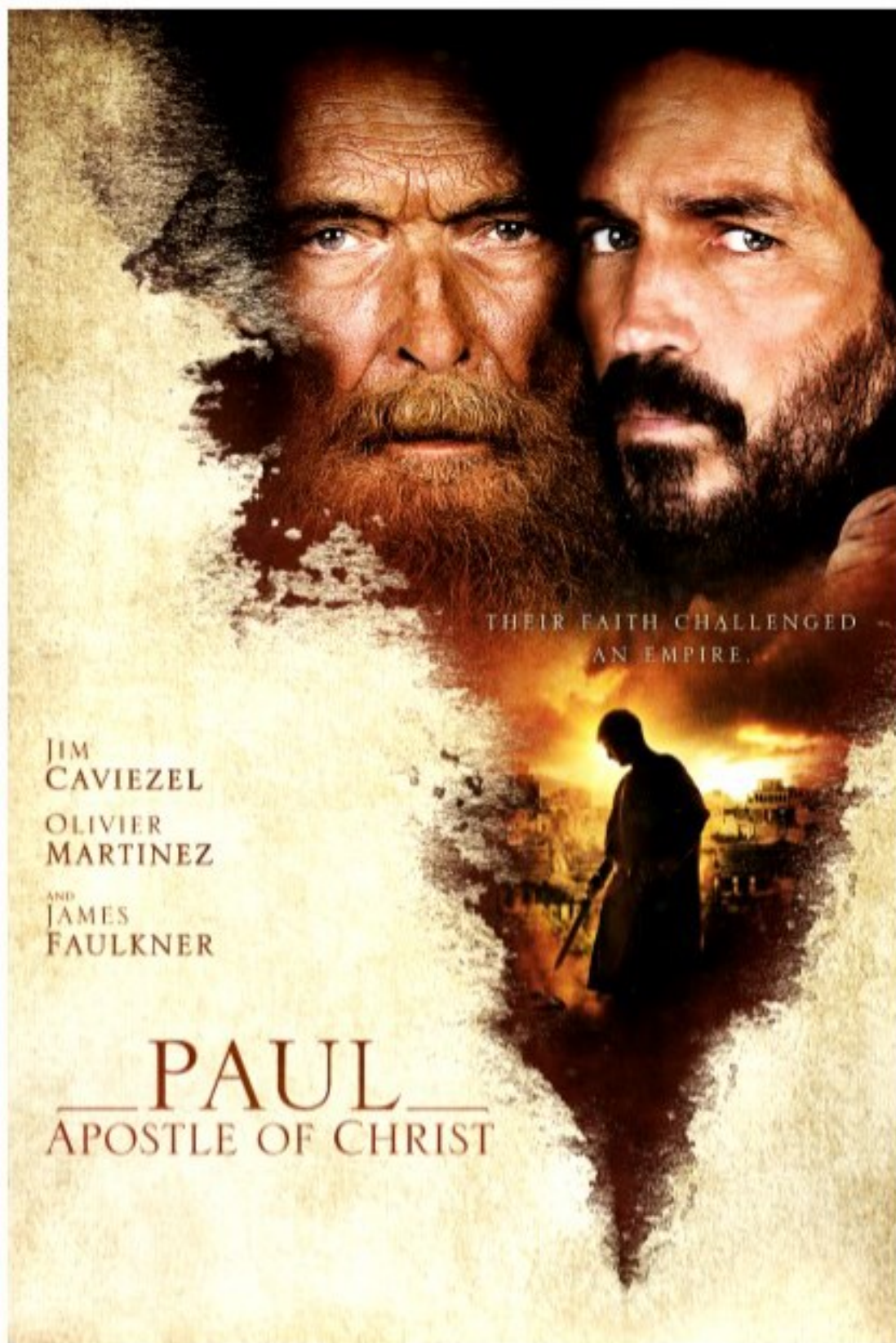
