Remember St Paul warns us in Ephesians 6:12, *"For our struggle is not with the flesh and blood but with principalities and powers, with the world rulers of this present darkness, with the evil spirits in the heavens."*

And in 1 Peter 5:8-9a *"Stay sober and alert. Your opponent the devil is prowling like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour."*

*Resist him, solid in your faith."*

We will do our best to resist him, and I urge all to join in saying this prayer. We will say it at the beginning of Mass, beginning Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup>. The prayer can be found in the front of the hymnals.


