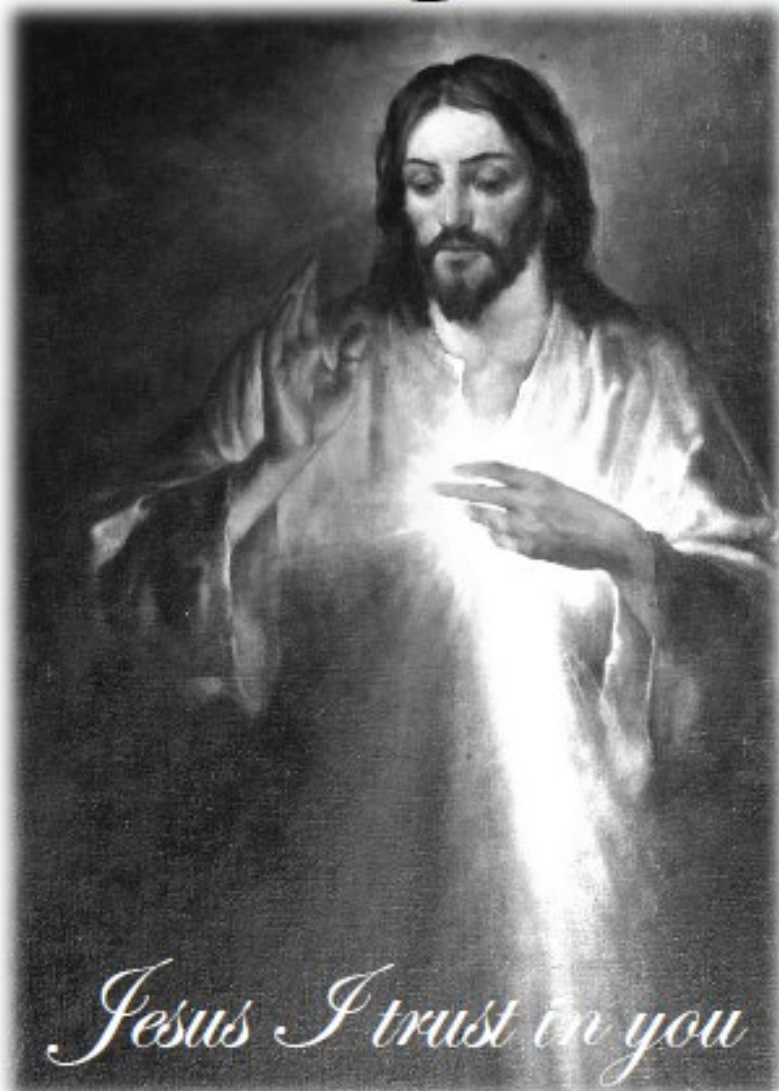

We will pray a Divine Mercy Holy Hour together on Divine Mercy Sunday at 3pm.

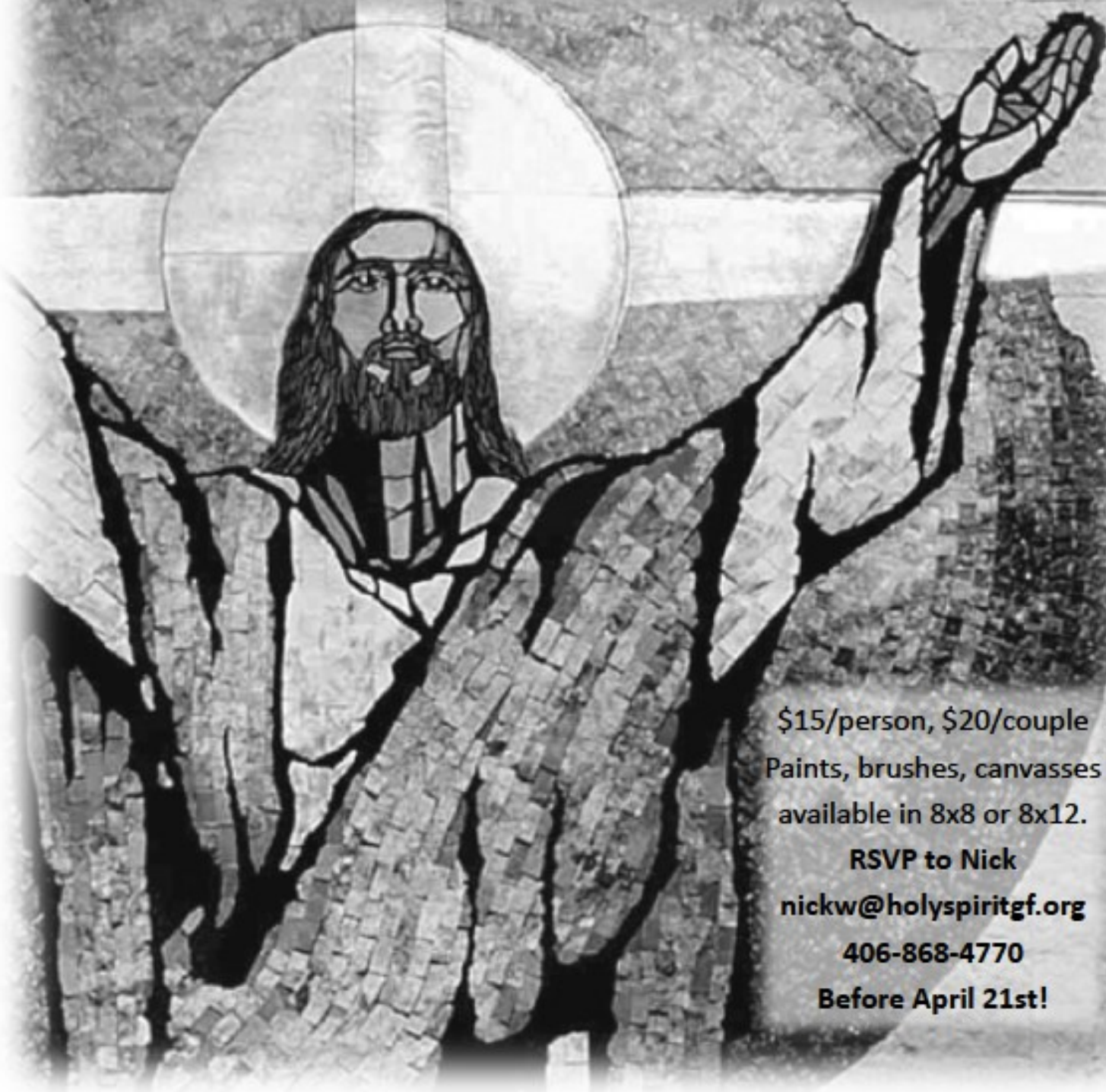
