The outward action of care and concern is as needed as the inward prayer of care and concern. What is not healthy and is in the way is anxiety and worry. As we listen to the Martha and Mary story in the Gospel this weekend, Jesus addresses this with Martha. He could include those of us who pray and then continue to worry over the answer He gives. Family Promise is all about the care of the children. If children are in their homes, sociologists say, they feel more secure and stable. There is a lot of worry and anxiety for families who are homeless. The basic needs of the family unit are not being met. Those of us who work in the Family Promise Program see only a small portion of the successes of the families who graduate from the Program. Our contribution might be small but it could be the difference for a parent between being worried sick and believing there is Hope on the other side of the family's time in the Program.

Kathie Malby will unlock the Monsignor House from 9:00-10:30 on Tuesday July 23. Please come by for a visit and a cup of coffee. The Monsignor House is available for all parishioners. It is our own home for those who are homeless families with the Family Promise Great Falls Program or for those parishioners who want to meet as a small study group. We are located at 2810 Central.
