





### Helping a Grieving Friend

#### Grief has no timeline

- Understand that each person grieves in their own way
- Listen with attention and interest from the heart
- Allow space for the grieving person to
  - talk if they choose
  - tell their story as often as needed
- Do not be afraid of
  - feeling uncomfortable yourself
  - silence
  - tears, and emotional expressions
- Listen, listen, listen

#### Some things to say

- "I can't imagine how painful this must be"
- "I heard/understand/I'm sorry...."
- Use the word died
- Be genuine, acknowledge the situation, or say "I don't know what to say"
- Call the deceased person by name when talking
  - "I was thinking about \_\_\_\_\_" and then mention a memory or two

#### Avoid saying

- "I know just how you feel"
- "you have to be strong"
- "they are in a better place"
- "God only gives us what we can handle"
- "it's a blessing in disguise"
- Children should be given honest information about the death
  - Use correct terms such as "grandpa died"

#### Ways to help

- Shopping for food or supplies
- Preparing food use disposable dishes
- o Attend the vigil and funeral
- o Pray for your grieving friend and let them know that you are doing so
- Consider having a Mass said
- Share an activity: walk, coffee or lunch, game, movie.....
- Offer to attend Mass with them, sometimes attending Mass can be difficult
- Consider specifically reaching out to them during these times as well as holiday's anniversaries etc., birthday's etc, can be challenging
- Phone calls or cards can be ways of supporting your friend

#### Who we are:

Holy Spirit Bereavement Team are volunteers and not meant to substitute for counselors; we don't want to be perceived as anything more than fellow Catholics who want to walk with you during this difficult and sometimes confusing time, following Jesus' mandate to "comfort those who mourn." Matt. 5:4

<u>Team members include experience with</u>: nursing, teaching, hospice nursing, training, social working and navigating paperwork

We come from surviving these experiences: losses from suicide, miscarriages, traumatic, sudden, and natural death; loss of children and grandchildren, spouses, parents, siblings, and friends
