### **Stewardship**

The Monsignor House is available for all parishion-Family Promise ers. It is our own home for those who are homeless of Great Falls families with the Family Promise Great Falls Program or for those parishioners who want to meet as a small study group. We are located at 2810 Central Avenue.

This week the Monsignor House became a recipient of several blankets. Each of you seems to find a way to do the work of the House. Your volunteering through your generosity serves the House in several ways. There are donations made that stay at the House and are used in similar ways that any household uses its things: Couches for sitting, plastic containers to send lunches out with families, sheets to cover mattresses, brooms and house hold cleaners to make sure the House is as clean as any of our homes. Another was your generosity serves the House is the gifting of your donations to families who are moving into their own homes or apartments. If a little child becomes attached to a toy we do not take it away from them but send it with them with our love. If a family needs double wide sheets that we do not need, we give them so they can cover their mattress. So your gifting our Holy Spirit home benefits both the Monsignor House directly and families if we have something they need and we are able to share too. We also call St. Vincent de Paul to come and get large items that we no longer use such as an old chair. And...when we are hosting the Program we oftentimes have food that is left over. We take that to the Mission and share with their kitchen. We are careful to not build up supplies in the House so that we do not have outdated cans and boxes of foodstuff. That is one of the reasons we offer sign-ups for the Monsignor House 4 times a year. Thank you so much for your generous Holy Spirit hearts!


