To Holy Spirit Parishioners:

It is not uncommon for a priest (actually it is quite common), around five years of ordination, to require some time to address issues with ministry. This applies to Fr. Garrett Nelson. I have met with him numerous times in recent months to discuss his ministry and judged he needed some time to sort a few things out. At the recommendation of a good priest friend of mine, I have asked Fr. Garrett to spend a few months at Madonna House in Combermere, Ontario. He is very much in agreement that this would be a helpful location to work on some issues. It essentially will be a mini-sabbatical.

Madonna House is an intentional Catholic Association of the Faithful, lay women, men and priests and has about 200 members. It was founded by Catherine Doherty (a confrere of Dorothy Day) in 1947. A couple of years ago, I spent about a week there myself and know it to be holy ground. The members of the community are incredibly supportive and will provide a good environment for him to think and pray as well as enter into the pattern of life of the community. While there, Fr. Garrett will be able to receive solid spiritual direction from one of the priests of the community.

Please pray for Fr. Garrett. Plans are for him to travel there in early October through December and then return.
