## **"Letter to a Suffering Church" Book**

Brothers and sisters, we are sure most of you are aware of the horrific sexual abuse crisis that has haunted our Church, especially in recent months. We all grieve the wicked ways that priests have abused children, seminarians, and other vulnerable people. Many of us feel, understandably, demoralized and defeated.

Most of us are wondering, what should we do? What should we do as a Church—as an institution—to bring about reform and renewal, but also as individuals? What can I do?

With these scandals in mind, our parish has decided to share with you a new book by Bishop Robert Barron. Bishop Barron is a bishop in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and he's the founder of Word on Fire Catholic Ministries. His book is titled *Letter to a Suffering Church: A Bishop Speaks on the Sexual Abuse Crisis*.

We've ordered a copy of the book for every family in the parish and it will be arriving in your mail box within the next week, and we think you'll find it helpful and uplifting. It's not a dry, hollow statement. It's a true cry from the heart. Bishop Barron provides clear insight on the crisis, advice on why we should stay in the Church—clinging to Christ and fighting on behalf of the victims—and where we should go from here.

The hope is that you read it slowly and attentively. Then after finishing the book, you are encouraged to pass it on to a friend or family member who could use it, or to anyone struggling with the Church during this crisis.

If after reading the book you are interested in discussion with other parishioners, we are offering the following options for dialogue:


**Option one for further discussion:** If you'd like to be part of a study group with other parishioners, we will be using the group discussion guide that accompanies this book. This group discussion guide will be used to facilitate a dialogue with people from our faith community. The dialogue will take place on: **Thursday December 5, 2019 6-8:30pm @ Sts. Peter & Paul Center Gym**, we will gather for a soup and bread supper and discussion of the book.

**Second Option for further discussion:** You can choose to read through this book together, with other parishioners, one chapter per week over the next five weeks. To help with that, Bishop Barron has created a short video series to guide us along.

With this video series, you'll receive one short email or text message per week, over the next five weeks—so just five total. Each message corresponds to one of the five chapters in the book, and each message will contain a short video reflection by Bishop Barron followed by a few discussion questions we can discuss together as a parish, using the Flocknote system. It's a chance for you to dialogue with fellow parishioners, and also ask questions of and interact with your priests about this important topic. Again, please know we are not alone in our grief or our hope for the future of our Church. We are a family of believers, and together we will cling to Jesus Christ who is Mercy, Light and Love and bring about justice and peace for a church suffering.

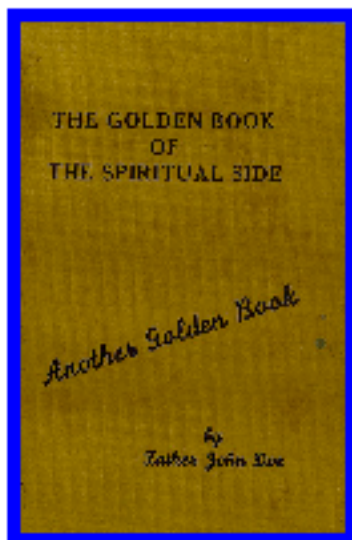

To have your gift qualify for the “*Montana Charitable Endowment Tax Credit*”, call the Catholic Foundation of Eastern Montana at (406) 315-1765 or email [info@catholicfoundationmt.org](mailto:info@catholicfoundationmt.org). They are happy to help structure gifts for our parishioners, for our parish endowments, at no charge.

**Please note:** Any size gift may be given to an endowment. All gifts help and there is no minimum amount. However, if you wish to receive the Montana Charitable Endowment Tax Credit for your gift, the minimum qualifying gift is \$1,000 with the Catholic Foundation of Eastern Montana. Tax benefits increase with the size of the gift. Following is an example for this minimum amount:

**Example of a Qualifying Gift:**

**How to make a \$1,000 donation cost less than \$400\***



You donate \$1,000 to the endowment of your choice at the Catholic Foundation of Eastern Montana through a planned gift.

Your Montana taxes are reduced by a tax credit equal to 40% of the charitable deduction for your gift. Your donation may also be deductible on your federal tax return, *if* you itemize.

\*Net cost to you when making a \$1,000 gift for our parish endowment.
