SO YOU ARE THINKING ABOUT CUM CHRISTO?

You've been thinking about going to a Cum Christo? Great! Those of us who have gone to one think it is a wonderful way to meet Christ in a new perspective, to find that Christ love s you, and it's a fun way to meet new friends. This is not the only way to do these things, but is one aid or tool.

You will find that the Cum Christo is not a cult. It is simply a restating of things you have heard and talked about for years – grace, sacraments, and piety. The joyous part is that lay women and men who give talks on these subjects will share their lives with you. They not only talk about specific topics, but they add what it means, or has meant, in their lives.

On Thursday evening, you will listen to an opening talk or instruction, sing a little, and go to chapel. The first day of Cum Christo deals with you and your relationship to yourself, the world, and to God, so Thursday night you will be asked to observe a spirit of retreat in silence.

Silence isn't so bad. It does give you some time to think, and because you don't have to talk, you can forget about witty sayings and smiling at all the "strange" people. You are only asked to observe silence this one night, so don't let it get you down.

Friday morning, you will be assigned to a table with four or five others. You will get to know these folks well during the weekend, and you will share with them your gripes, your joys, and your thoughts. On this day, the talks deal with ideals – what's your goal? With grace – what does God offer you? with laity – what are you supposed to be doing while you are sitting in that pew? And it deals with holiness. Remember, these are all just ideas, not "have to dos".

There are chapel visits in the morning and evening each day and Eucharist most days too. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are served – no meals to fix, or dishes to wash – with talks intermingled amongst all of that. Should you have a special concern, the priest will be there to talk with you, and you will probably find him pretty helpful. There will be drinks and snacks available, some books for you to look through and purchase if you so desire, people to talk with and ideas to think about.

You will find that Cum Christo is not a magical weekend that does away with strife, or dissolves worries into smoke and thunder. Cum Christo strives to show you that God is alive and well, and doesn't try to "convert" anyone. Any commitments you make during the weekend are strictly between you and God.

Love abounds on this weekend, and it is because of these feelings of love and joy that no one can really explain Cum Christo to you. It is something that must be lived, and unless you live the Cum Christo, there is no way we can fully share it with you. You have to go and see for yourself!

Sound exciting? We think so, and we are sure you will find that true also. Try it - we did and we liked it!
