

In Psalm 72, prayed this weekend, we hear the psalmist state: For he shall rescue the poor when he cries out, and the afflicted when he has no one to help him. He shall have pity for the lowly and the poor; the lives of

Herod did not have respect for anyone, including the new baby that was born: since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel. Herod felt the threat so keenly that he sent soldiers to kill the innocent babies 3 years old and younger! Our homeless families are folks who need a hand up and in Family Promise we are able to provide that through our time, shelter, and food.
