The National Family Promise program is restructuring ways of approaching our rotational program for the guest families we host. When we receive guidelines regarding our volunteering, we will let you know through the bulletin. In the meantime, the rotational part of our Family Promise program is suspended so direction can be developed and then implemented.

As we come out of our homes to encounter each other again, renewed in our relationships, blessed by our Church, let us take to heart the words of our Lord, Jesus: *I will not leave you orphans...*

This week we do not have an update on the guest family who is being housed in a home donated by a family who were planning to sell their home before all the shelter-in-place began. The last information we received was that our family qualifies for an apartment and is awaiting notice as to when they can move. Please pray for them and for the Family Promise Program.
