Poverty is an issue and in this day and age we are aware of its presence more than ever. We have reminders through email, snail mail, walking down the street, TV news and through the many different ways in which we volunteer. In the secular world, among Christians and other faith traditions, we are trying to make a dent in it. Family Promise is one of those programs whose “promise” is to eradicate poverty one family at a time. This beautiful program, that impacts so many people, is looking at the pandemic that has beset our world, and needs to find other ways in which to care for the children who are the center of Family Promise. By assisting the parents to stabilize their lives, by giving that “hand-up” we have cared for and released many families to become successful and productive in their private lives. The children “win” every time we have done this.

The workers and supporters of the Monsignor House have rejoiced every time one of our families moves into their own home. So it is with a heavy heart we need to address how we do volunteering within this program at the Monsignor House. We can no longer have the personal contact as we had in the past, through sharing meals together and staying the night at the Monsignor House. The Monsignor House is not suited as a static site because of the need for updating its plumbing and heating and its small size. We cannot house people there IF there is another shelter-in-place. It is too costly to have them housed in a motel for any length of time (we found that out with our last young family). So, we are closing the Monsignor House as a Family Promise site. Kathie Malby has met with the interim Executive Director of Family Promise, the Family Promise board chair, and the staff at the downtown location. She also met with Aubrey Rearden and Mark Meyer to discuss the issues surrounding our volunteers at Holy Spirit and usage of the Monsignor House. At this time, we do not know where this pandemic will take us, but we do know, for now, we cannot proceed as we once did.

AT THS TIME — Family Promise Great Falls needs to re-group and decide on 2 things: a) Search for a new director; and, b) if/when a new director is chosen, move the program into a new direction for “Eviction Prevention.” What the Family Promise board will do has not been decided. In the mean time we ask for your continued prayer support. We hear loudly and clearly in our Liturgy of the Word today ~ we will be rewarded by our Lord when we serve others, no matter how small the service. Prayer is one way we serve. Let us do it with fullness of heart in service to the King of Kings.

Thank you to all of you who supported the Monsignor House with supplies during this time. Your generosity is deeply appreciated.
