### Youth Minister

We are looking for a qualified individual to continue a vibrant, relational ministry to the youth of our Parish in grades 7-12. Youth Minister is responsible for planning, programming, supervising, coordinating, and executing Youth Ministry in our parish. This position is responsible for recruiting, training, and supervising a staff of adult volunteers, developing youth leadership and nurturing spiritual growth. A bachelors degree in Education, Religious Studies or Theology or equivalent experience in parish ministry in the area of religious formation or youth ministry preferred. This is a 10 month (August–May) 20 hour work week position and individual must be available evenings and weekends as needed. This is a salaried position, compensation will be based on education and experience.

### Elementary Formation Coordinator

We are looking for a person to join our formation team to Coordinate Catholic Religious Formation to our Pre-K - 6th Grade parishioners and their families. This individual is responsible for planning, programming, supervising, coordinating and executing the Elementary Formation Program to include weekly formation classes and vacation bible School. This individual is responsible to recruit, oversee, and train a staff of adult volunteers. Qualified applicants will possess a degree in Religious Formation, Theology, or Education (or equivalent experience), understand and accept Catholic theology and teachings, be willing to work in cooperation with the parish staff and pastor. This is a part time, 10 month (20 hour flexible work week, available weekends and evenings as needed) salaried position, compensation is based on education and experience.
