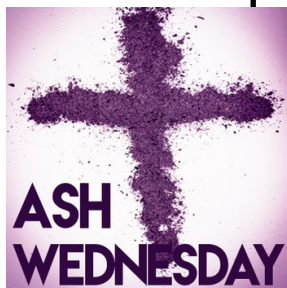

Reflection: What is our purpose here on earth and what has the Lord, Jesus, called each of us to do? We are challenged in the 4 readings this weekend to look at our call. Job is seeking God’s response to the sad direction of his life. He has lost everything and like many of us, he is looking for the hope that is hidden from him at the place in his life. Our Psalm response praises God for the care He gives to His people who are hurting, much like Job. Paul is encouraging the Corinthians witnessing with his life that he is “all things to all, to save at least some.” And, the healings Jesus does in the presence of so many begins to spread throughout the Sea of Galilee. He says to His Apostles: “Let us go to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose I have come.” These readings reach out and touch each one of us in different ways. The diversity of our calls, the development of our personalities, the generosity of our time here on earth, are as different as all of the writers we hear from today. Job, the Psalmist, St. Paul and St. Mark give encouragement to us as we sort through our lives and in the lives of others, most especially the lives of the most vulnerable.
