Greetings to all on this Palm Sunday,


As we reflect on the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem and inevitable journey to His Cross, I think that it is an appropriate time for us to make distinct the location of our Tabernacle here at Holy Spirit.

I have decided through much prayer, advisement, and discernment to move the Tabernacle to a more prominent position in the church. The Tabernacle, according to Canon Law (CCL 938), should be readily visible to everyone who enters any Catholic Church. It should be in a position of prominence, so that all can worship and pray before the Lord, wherever and whenever they are in the church. Because of the design of our church there is no perfect place, but I believe it should be in an obvious place, easy to see, especially for those visiting.

As we journey into this Holy Week we will situate the Tabernacle in its new location toward the front of the church. This will not only allow for better visibility but also for more efficient functionality of this Most Holy Reservation of the Most Blessed Sacrament. I thank you for your patience and understanding,
