

Monsignor House Reflection: Our readings this weekend continue the message of our Holy Eucharist, culminating in Jesus stating clearly: "I am the bread of life, whoever come to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." So we all come, rich, poor, tall, thin, happy, sad, tired, energetic. We come to him because he feeds us himself and we become Christ-like treating each other with respect and kindness. The saints who found their nourishment in Jesus, our Christ, continue to guide and encourage us to meet the needs of God's people:

When I give bread to the poor, they call me a saint...when I ask why the poor have no bread, they call me a Communist. (-Archbishop Oscar Romero 1917-1980); The bread you store up belongs to the hungry; the cloak that lies in your chest belongs to the naked; the gold you have hidden in the ground belongs to the poor. (-St. Basil the Great); The mystery of the poor is this: That they are Jesus, and what you do for them you do for Him. (-Dorothy Day).
