



Monsignor House Reflection: The Monsignor Joseph Gluzsek Hospitality House has been served by volunteers for the past 7 years! Our volunteers found their own niche for how they are called to serve. Some were trained in working directly with the families through preparing suppers, bringing them to the MH and staying to eat with them and clean up the supper with them. Building relationships is what community is all about and our Holy Spirit Parish understands that. Some volunteers were comfortable staying over night so the families had friendly faces to visit with or to talk to about their concerns. Other volunteers came to clean the house in between hosting families. There were some volunteers who provided provisions for the house such as paper products, coffee, or breakfast and luncheon supplies. There were volunteers who faithfully brought in the cots and hauled them up the stairs so our families had beds to sleep in. Some volunteers gave one time and others gave every time. There were those volunteers who raked lawns or washed linens. Whatever needed doing was done human to human. In today's 1st reading we hear Joshua's words from centuries ago: "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord." Whenever we serve, in any way for those in need, we serve the Lord.
