Needs and thanks for the Monsignor House: At this time, we are doing very well. Thank you to whoever left the bags of supplies and to the 2 men who came and moved the couch and love seat from the basement and into the breezeway of the building. Thank you Holy Spirit Parish, for your continued concern for the needs for the Monsignor House.

Monsignor House Reflection: The Monsignor Joseph Gluzsek Hospitality House had 3 co-coordinators to care for the weeks when families were hosted in the House from 2015-2020 for the Family Promise Program. These coordinators worked in tandem matching their leadership gifts for the greater good of the Monsignor House and for the Holy Spirit community. We had Girl Scouts who created gift bags for welcoming our families when they arrived. We also had the support of the Knights of Columbus to help with the yards and the painting of the windows. The LDS churches on the eastside of Great Falls requested opportunity to serve Family Promise and needed a facility in which to host families. They approached Holy Spirit Parish and we happily said yea which offered a 2-week window of time for our families to stay at the Monsignor House. They also spear-headed a painting project which spruced up the front window at the MH. Other supporters of the Monsignor House were members of the Altar Society which generously donated money for the upkeep of the MH. At this time, 1 coordinator is working directly with the MH and in cooperation with the Episcopal community and the St. Jude Conference to assist the family who came in August 2020. The work of this little home is continuing. Moses said to his people: *for what great nation is there that has gods so close to it as the Lord, our God, is to us whenever we call upon him?* God uses people to do the work of God here on earth. All the volunteers that serve the Monsignor House rely on the charisms from God's own Spirit to minister to the House that is a home for those who come to stay for a short time or for a long time.

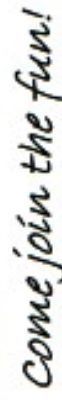
