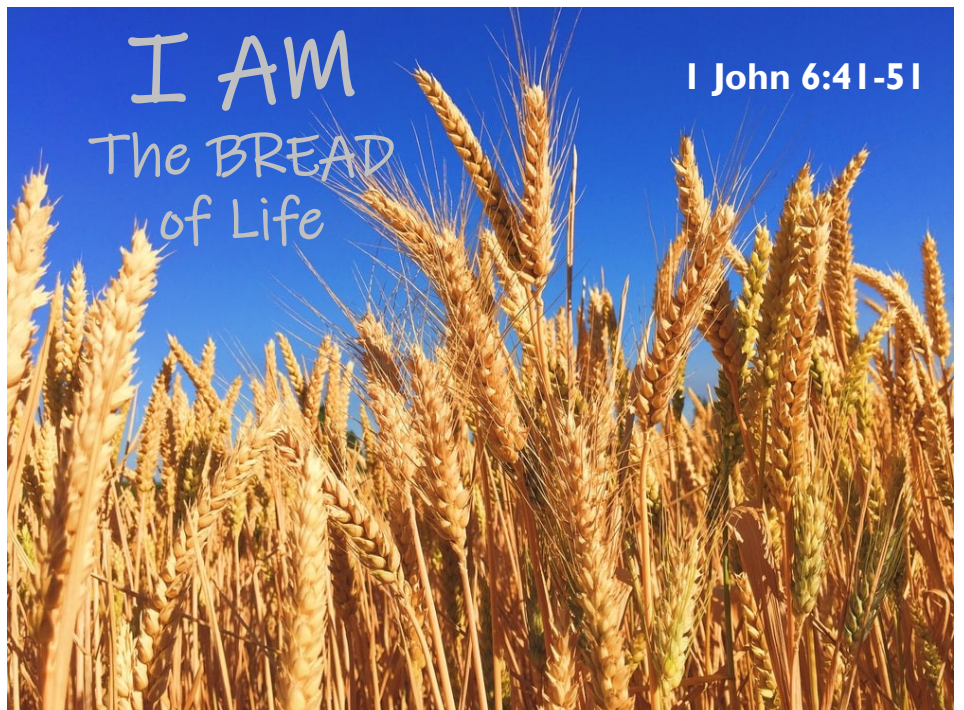

Our house which is named the Monsignor Joseph Gluszek Hospitality House opened up on January 15, 2015. After that day, our gift of hospitality accepted the strangers that came in the form of families. The families had some of the issues already mentioned above. Some had other, more pressing issues. They came in all forms that we know as family in our American society. We have not judged. We have served. This is all we are called to do. St. Teresa of Calcutta said: *We are not called to be successful. We are called to be faithful.* Throughout our summer Gospels, on the Eucharist, Jesus show us the way.
