CATECHISM CORNER

What is the Catholic understanding of "Grace"? (CCC 1996-2005) "Grace is favor, the free, undeserved help that God gives us to respond to the call to be children of God, adoptive sons, partakers of the divine life and of eternal life" (1995). Our Sacramental life in Christ is a consistent movement away from the state of sin into a state of grace. We are induced into the intimacy of the Trinitarian life. It is a supernatural gift that both heals our souls of the wounds of sin and sanctifies them. To dwell in a state of grace, or habitual grace, is to conform our wills to God's Will and cooperate with the Holy Spirit, justifying us in faith and perfecting us in love by grace. Though a free gift of God's initiative, grace demands man's free response in belief (faith) and good works (love). By our good work in love (charity) we may collaborate with the Spirit for the salvation of others. "If I am not (in God's grace), let it please Him to put me in it; if I am, may it please God to keep me there." -St. Joan of Arc
