

Monsignor House Reflection: The youngest of Jesus' Apostles was John. It is believed he had been a follower of John the Baptist along with Andrew, Peter's brother. John the Baptist pointed to Jesus and called him the 'Lamb of God' and some of the disciples of John the Baptist left him to follow Jesus. They were excited to find the one they thought might be the Messiah so the new followers of Jesus talked about Jesus and those people, too, began to "follow Jesus". Some of the followers, the ones we call Apostles (in early times Apostle was one who follows an important teacher) were present at the wedding feast of Cana. St. John, the author of today's narrative says: "...Jesus did this in the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples (in early times disciple means a follower of a teacher, leader or philosopher) began to Believe in him." In caring for others, it is important to remember we are witnesses of the glory of Jesus and his miracles. The people who live in the Monsignor House are aware of our kindness and generosity. As the followers of Jesus today, we are witnesses of His glory so we do the simple tasks of caring for the Monsignor House and anyone who stays there.

Catechism Corner

CATECHISM CORNER

What is meant by the phrase "life in Christ"? (CCC 1691-1698) Jesus uses the analogy of a tree to describe our relationship with him: "I am the vine you are the branches" (John 15:5). Jesus is the source of our life, "through him was life" (John 1:4). By the Sacraments we are saved from the damnation and death of sin into a life of grace, grafted mystically to Christ's own body. Through faith we confess what the Sacraments confer, that "we have become children of God and partakers of the Divine Nature" (1692). By this grace, inspiration, and guidance from the Holy Spirit, the Christian is called to "live a life worthy of the Gospel." We, therefore, live a life modeled after Christ and informed by the Holy Spirit, by grace, by the Beatitudes, knowledge of sin and forgiveness, intentional human virtue developed into Christian virtue, and the commandments of love set forth in the 10 Commandments (1697). Why? Jesus says: "If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete." (John 15:9-10)
