## Catechism Corner

### CATECHISM CORNER

Do Catholics “have” to obey the Church rules? (CCC 2040-43) The moral life, directed and sustained by Divine Revelation, is not a subset separated from the rest of our spiritual life. With an obedient “filial spirit toward the Church” we are empowered by grace to resist the seduction of sin through faithful participation in the Sacraments (2040). The Church has set out minimal precepts in which we may be assured growth in spirit of prayer, moral effort and charity for God and neighbor (2041). These five precepts are: 1) Attend Mass on every Holy Day of Obligation (including every Sunday) and rest from needless labor. 2) Confess your sins at least once per year (preferably during the season of Lent) and when conscience of mortal sin, to ensure proper disposition for reception of the Eucharist. 3) Receive the Eucharist at least during the Easter Season. 4) Observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church to prepare for liturgy and develop self-mastery. 5) Provide for the material needs of the Church, according to each one's ability (2042-43). The gift of faith comes in our baptism from the Church, who gives maternal wisdom for its cultivation.
