Catechism Corner

Why do Christians pray? (CCC 2685, 2697-99)  
“Prayer is the new life of the heart” (2697). As we turn our life over to God we learn to abide in Him through a life in Christ and a life in prayer. For many, the Christian family is the first school of faithful prayer. We learn from our parents how to pray as the “Domestic Church” and, through daily family prayer, how to persevere in prayer (2685). The rhythms of life hour to hour, day to day, and year to year can be focused into times and seasons of prayer: morning and evening prayer, Liturgy of the Hours, grace before and after meals, the Liturgical Calendar, the Mysteries of the Holy Rosary, holy hours, Eucharistic Adoration, and above all Sunday Liturgy centered on the Holy Eucharist all provide rich moments of remembering God (2698). “The Lord leads all persons by paths and in ways pleasing to him and each person responds according to his heart’s resolve and personal expression of his prayer” (2699). The Church, however, retains three main “expressions of prayer: vocal, meditative, and contemplative,” all of which strengthen and demonstrate the common trait of “composure of heart” (2699). We must will to pray to God at all times by praying with particular intensity at certain times.
