Catechism Corner

Next in the Creed, we profess that On the third day He rose again. What does this mean? (CCC 638-655)

"We bring you the good news that what God promised to the fathers, this day he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus." (Acts 13:32-33) The Resurrection of Jesus is the crowning truth of the faith believed and lived as the central truth of the Paschal mystery, along with the cross. The mystery of Christ's resurrection is a real event, verified in the New Testament. "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen." (Lk 24:5-6) That empty tomb and the linen cloths was an essential sign for all, signifying that by God's power Christ's body had escaped the bonds of death and corruption. Its discovery by the disciples was the first step toward recognizing the very fact of the Resurrection. Mary Magdalene and the holy women were the first to encounter the Risen One, (Mk 16:1) thus being the first messengers of the Resurrection for the apostles. (Lk 24:9-10) By means of touch and sharing meals, the risen Jesus establishes direct contact with his disciples. This verifies that the risen body is the same body that had been crucified, bearing the signs of his Passion. (Lk 24: 30, 39-43) This Paschal mystery has two aspects: by his death, Christ liberates us from sin; by his Resurrection, he opens for us the way to a new life. (CCC 654) This new life is above all justification that reinstates us in God's grace. The Justification consists in victory over the death caused by sin and a new participation in grace. (Cf. Eph 2:4-5) In Christ, Christians' lives are swept up by Christ into the heart of divine life so that they may "live no longer for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised." (2 Cor 5:15)

Holy Spirit Parish and Holy Spirit School are hiring!

The Parish has 4 positions available:

- ⇒ **Director of Religious Formation:** This position supervises the planning, programming, implementation, and evaluation of a comprehensive religious formation program to include Elementary, Youth, adult and Sacramental Preparation programs. This position is 20 hour/week.
- ⇒ **Elementary Formation Coordinator:** This position administers the Elementary Formation Program for Pre-School through 6th grade, Vacation Bible School and the Completion of Initiation Program. This position is 20 hours/week.
- ⇒ **Facility and Grounds Maintenance Coordinator:** This position is responsible for identifying, reporting and coordinating maintenance efforts for the Parish. The coordinator will serve as chairman of the Parish Maintenance Committee which advises Pastoral Council regarding repair, Maintenance and safety issues within the Parish facilities and grounds. This position is 10-20 hours/week.
- ⇒ **Christian Service Coordinator:** The objective of this position is to enable the people of Holy Spirit Parish to serve one another within the parish and the community. The coordinator will develop a ministry to needs of parish members and other groups requiring support; organize a ministry to the parish members who are terminally ill and homebound; and administer the Parish Relief Fund, act as resource person for the Christian Service Commission. This position is 20 hours/week.

The School has these positions available:

- ⇒ **Elementary Teacher:** This position is perfect for a self-motivated and experienced teacher. Responsibilities include grading assignments, Evaluating progress and planning educational activities.
- ⇒ **Extended Care Director:** This position is for a qualified childcare director to manage the day-to-day operations and establish and sustain a positive learning environment for the children in the Extended Care Program.
- ⇒ **Bus Driver:** We are looking for a responsible and reliable school bus driver to transport students to and from school as well as to and from special events. The driver is in charge of following a scheduled route and ensure passenger safety.

Employees of the Parish and the School receive free tuition for their children at Holy Spirit Catholic School.
