# **Administrator's Report**

Aubrey passed out and reviewed the budget with the council. Anticipate being 60,000 in the black this fiscal year.

Aubrey will dispense information regarding how much we owe on the church building and when we anticipate it being paid off. She will also send out information on how much we owe in regards to the settlement and when we anticipate that being complete.

## Follow up for Parish Mission and Fall Fest

Well attended. Noted that the students at Holy Spirit need 4 hours of service each month – keep them in mind for volunteering for future projects.

Discussion regarding need in the future for clarification of schedule of activities during parish mission.

Parish Council will serve coffee and rolls on October 23<sup>rd</sup> between masses. All council members asked to help if they are able. Baker Bob bakes the rolls, we need to set up, serve, and clean up.

Next meeting will sign a card to thank the Wingerters for all their work on the fall festival

Parish Properties Update: Boiler not functioning at Peter & Paul. Secondhand boiler available in Billings. Controls need to be updated. Cracks in wall, uneven floor. Finance Council suggested putting the property at St Peter and Paul and the surrounding land for sale. 16 years ago, to update building was 1.25 million and 150,000 to bulldoze. Discussed initial goal of the parish was to have a retirement housing, parish center, and school on the property that Holy Spirit is on now. Discussed possible sale of Peter and Paul property and Holy Spirit school and Holy Family property. Discussed that if the property on Central is sold, we would be responsible for finding housing/a convent for the Sisters of Divine Grace.

Next month will begin forming a committee to plan for the creation of a new parish center on the property. Timeline at this time for the project is unknown.
