# Ministry Spotlight: Seminarian Support

As men are discerning the call to priesthood, our Diocese wants to provide support. This begins with a Vocations Director, who will pray with and answer questions to help them discern what is the call of God in their lives. If they feel called to continue the path towards priesthood, the Diocese will also provide support for graduate level seminarian education to include tuition, books, room, boarding, and even some travel expenses.

Additionally, we also have a priest that is specifically assigned to Seminarian Formation who will support them through the process

up to and including their ordination, when they will become transitional deacons and then priests of the Diocese. These are important pieces of support, so that as these men are working towards priesthood, they do not have to worry about the financial aspects of the process. As we hope to continue to grow our Seminarian program, we will continue to need support for this fund.




Spring is here and we are preparing our garden area for another summer of pro-

#### Catechism Corner

Did Jesus actually rise from the dead? (CCC 639-647)

Christ's Resurrection is both a historical and transcendent event . The New Testament bears witness that Jesus appeared "first to Peter, then the Twelve, then 500 at once..." (1 Corinthians 15:3-6). The discovery of the empty tomb on Easter morning is the initial fact of evidence for many of the disciples, Mary Magdalene first, then Peter, then John (640). These witnesses of the Resurrection carry their testimonies for the rest of their lives to evangelize the world and, with the Divine Assistance, build the Catholic Church we receive today (642). It has been of historical importance, and in fact impossible not to acknowledge, the very fact of Jesus' Resurrection, not as some mythical legend or mystical interpretation, for the radical change of heart from desolate despair to evangelical fervor can only be explained by the physical experience of the Risen Lord (643). The nature of His Body both bears the resemblance of his pre-death body by the tangible wounds and shared meals which still persist. However, it has transitioned in a formal way from the familiar physical nature to a glorified nature, not bound by space or time, capable of passing through walls or vanishing at will (645). This inexplicable reality is at the heart of the Gospel and transcends history. No longer does Christ appear in human form, but the fact of history is passed along through the Good News of the Church (647), and the mystery persists and is transmitted by the grace of the Sacraments through the liturgical celebrations of the Holy Mass.

Sean Donnelly, Ed.D - Named as Principal of Great Falls Central Catholic High School

It is with great pleasure that the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings announces that the Great Falls Central Catholic High School Principal Search Committee has selected Sean Donnelly, Ed.D, as the new Principal of Great Falls Central Catholic High School.

The Search Committee was made up of Great Falls Catholic School stakeholders, including administrators, teachers, a board member, and clergy and staff from the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings.
