Catechism Corner

What is the effect of Baptism? (CCC 1262-1274)

In Baptism we die to sin with Christ. We emerge from the waters a new life in the Holy Spirit. In our Baptism all of our sins, original and personal, are forgiven. This does not, however, resolve the unnatural effect of original sin, namely concupiscence or the innate inclination to sin. Our Lord tells us that he "makes all things new" (Rev. 21:5). So we are made a new creation in Baptism, adopted children of God who have been grafted into the divine nature. As a gift on this joyful occasion, the Blessed Trinity grants sanctifying grace, which justifies us for salvation. This grace enables us to live according to the theological virtues in accordance with the Divine Will, to cooperate with the Holy Spirit, and to grow in goodness. Additionally, Christ initiates us into His Body, the Church, through the sacrament. This initiation inaugurates the evangelical offices of every Christian: to live as priests, prophets, and kings. As such it is the birthright of every Christian to proclaim the Gospel is all places and all times. This sacrament binds all Christians together in fraternal charity, even those who remain separated by doctrinal error. Finally, through Baptism Christ bestows on us an indelible mark of belonging to him. It is this sacramental character that enables and commits the Christian faithful to participate fully and actively in the liturgy. The mark of faith is the seal of eternal life and is the expectation of the beatific vision of God. By grace God calls all who trust in Him by faith to the waters of Baptism, and thus inaugurates the great adventure towards Christ in eternal life.

Dear Family and Friends of Great Falls Catholic Schools,

The 2023-2024 school year is off to a wonderful beginning. On Friday, August 25, we celebrated Mass of the Holy Spirit. It was a blessing to see all three schools—students and teachers—worshipping together at Our Lady of Lourdes Church.

The pastors, principals, and leaders from the parishes of Great Falls continue to work toward a unified Catholic school system in Great Falls. Working together we can better accomplish our mission of forming our students as disciples who love the Lord.

I want to take a moment to update you of where we currently are in the process of a unified school system. This goal of this process is one Catholic school system in Great Falls to better serve our students, family, teachers, and staff.

Here is some of the progress and ongoing work that has already begun:

- Aligning curriculum resources in our elementary grades, K-8, acknowledging that we currently have the same curriculum standards, and have had them for the past 10 years.
- There is already a unified athletic program in our schools.
- On September 18 our School Advisory Boards will have a joint training session facilitated by Christina McGill, Commissioner of Catholic Schools for the Diocese.
- In early October, we will host a Great Falls Central Catholic Schools launch party, celebrating our school system and revealing the vision for Catholic Education in Great Falls, be on the lookout for details.
- Quarterly All School Masses: Our first was Friday, the next one will be around All Saints
 Day, the third will be during Catholic Schools week (Jan. 28-Feb. 3), and the fourth will
 be at the end of the school year before graduations.
- We will also be working to bring our development teams together to form our new Mission Advancement Team.
- Continued opportunities for dialogue with our Catholic Communities and the community of Great Falls.

The fall of 2024 will usher us into a new era for Great Falls Central Catholic School. We plan to have a unified budget for the system. If all goes as planned, we will have a defined site plan for our schools.

The ultimate vision is a single, state-of-the-art Pre-K through 12 grade campus. A campus that will allow us to provide the best Catholic education that we can. A campus that glorifies God in all that we do through better stewardship of the resources available, by investing in and forming our faculty and staff, forming our students as disciples who love the Lord and share that love with the world. A campus that reflects our rich history and moves us into the future.

Please continue to hold our students, faculty, and staff in your prayers. Please also continue to pray for this process as we work for a unified and healthy school system for the benefit our of children. Please know of my prayers for you as we journey together.
