What is the RITE OF ELECTION and the CALL TO CONTINUING CONVERSION?

HE RITE OF ELECTION is the second step on the catechumens journey and leads them into the more intense period of Lenten preparation.

Those chosen inscribe their names in the BOOK OF THE ELECT as a promise of faithfulness to the call they have received from Christ. At the Easter Vigil, they will be baptized, confirmed and receive Eucharist. Thus they will be fully initiated into the Body of Christ.

HE CALL TO CONTINUING
CONVERSION is the final preparation
for those who, already baptized in
another Christian faith, wish to enter into full
communion with the Catholic Church through
the Sacraments of Confirmation and
Eucharist. The Church invites them to hear
anew the Lord's call to continual conversion and
to be faithful to their Baptism. At the Easter Vigil
these candidates will share fully in the
Sacramental life of the Catholic Church.



As they seek to become one with us, it is only fitting that we should be present to welcome and support them.
